- 3. Interview with Benton County Emergency Management Volunteers and Staff
- 4. Volunteer placement; if the BCEM Volunteer Corps is not a good fit, we will help to connect you with another program!

We offer emergency readiness training for individuals and communities, training for emergency and disaster response, and plenty of event and public engagement opportunities. Training schedule will vary based on interest level, and time of year.
